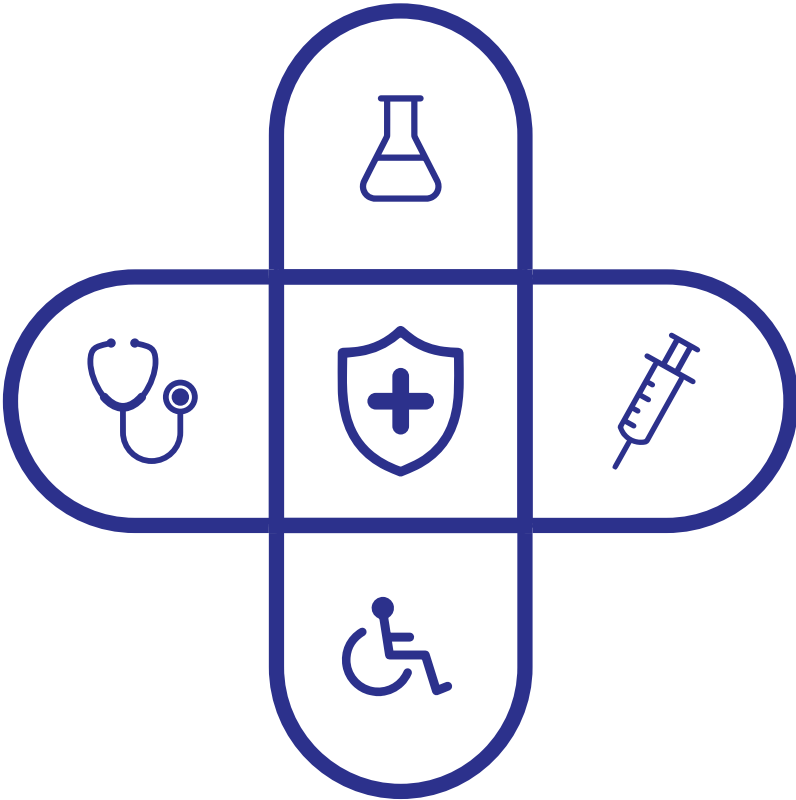


OUR MISSIONS

OUR ECOSYSTEM

The FM6M is part of a complete ecosystem made up of several entities, including two university hospitals, a simulation center, a training center, reference laboratories, specialized centers and many other structures working in the fields of science, health and scientific research.

This extensive network offers our students an exceptional opportunity to put their skills into practice in a real-life environment. In this way, they play an active role in their own academic development and benefit from a high-level education that integrates theory and practice in a highly skilled professional environment.

LEARNING PATH

Training and teaching

The new six-year medical curriculum is divided into 12 semesters :

S1 to S4 : This phase is devoted to pre-clinical and fundamental teaching, with basic scientific modules. During these semesters, students take part in an immersion course in the healthcare system in S1 and an immersion course in social medicine in S3. These internships are designed to make students aware early on in their medical training of certain important aspects of their future role.

From S5 to S10 : the student participates in part-time hospital externships and follows theoretical courses designed to acquire and develop clinical skills.

S11 and S12 : the focus is on full-time internships. During these 2 semesters, students complete 5 compulsory internships. The final assessment is based on objective, structured clinical examinations (OSCEs). During the same year, the student will benefit from two family medicine modules. They will also have to prepare their thesis for the title of Doctor of Medicine.



The internship competition is open to students from the 5th year of validated studies.

There are two routes to residency (specialist training) :

- On qualification for interns.
- By competition for those who have defended their thesis.

The period of speciality training is :

- 3 years for occupational medicine and sports medicine. By competition for those who have defended their thesis.
- 4 years for all medical and biological specialties (except internal medicine).
- 5 years for all surgical specialties, internal medicine and emergency and disaster medicine.

Since 2023, the Mohammed VI Foundation for Science and Health has been covering the training costs of interns and residents at our university.

After completing the specialization, candidates can apply for the university stream by taking the competitive examination for assistant professors. He or she can also join the ecosystem as a Hospital Practitioner or as a Temporary Specialist.

ADMISSION

Access to the Mohammed VI Faculty of Medicine is by means of a common entrance examination. In 2023, to be eligible for the competition, you need to have a scientific baccalaureate with an overall average of 13/20 or higher. In addition, a calculated average, based 75% on the overall average of the national exam and 25% on the overall average of the regional exam, must be equal to or higher than 12/20.

The competition covers four disciplines: mathematics, physics, chemistry and natural sciences (SVT).

EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES

The Mohammed VI Faculty of Medicine's teaching program incorporates simulation-based learning through the Mohammed VI International Center for Simulation in Science and Health, which offers a variety of innovative teaching resources, from "ANATOMAGE" tables for virtual dissection and study of the human body in 3D, to serious digital games, simulated patients and high-fidelity mannequins in realistic, immersive environments.

This 4200 m² space is a real simulation hospital. It gives students the opportunity to practice under real conditions to perfect their skills and apply the dogma :
"Never the first time on a patient".





The Mohammed VI Faculty of Medicine provides an e-learning platform and a reference-rich virtual library to give students quick access to extensive documentation. Our goal is to provide our students with all the resources they need, a supportive environment, and world-class educational programs.

In 2024, with the expansion of our digital student services, students will be able to access library digital resources, academic documents, exam results, and transcripts through their institutional email addresses. What's more, the assessments will be conducted on tablets provided by our Foundation, reinforcing the sustainable development dimension by eliminating the use of paper for exams.

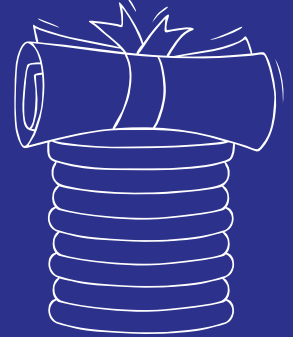

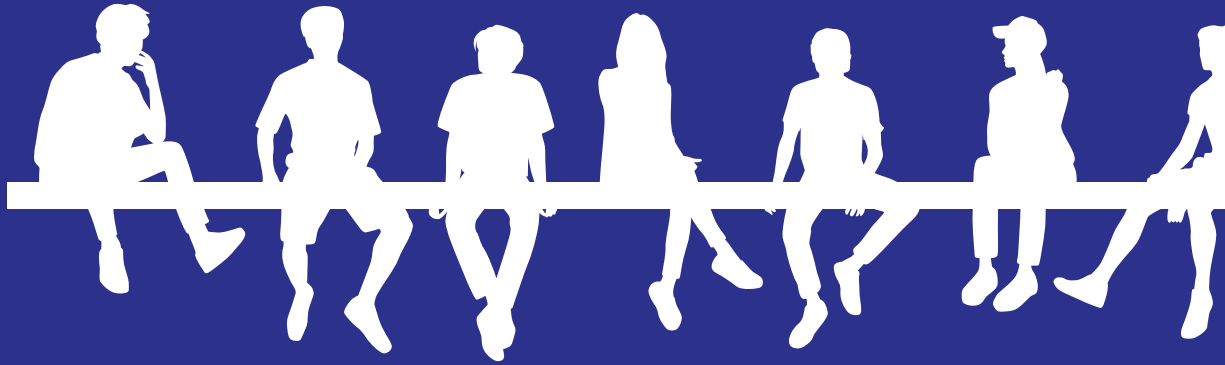
